## The Concordat to Support the Career Development of Researchers – September 2019

The University of Greenwich has signed up to the revised 'Concordat to Support the Career Development of Researchers 2019', commonly known as the **Researcher Development Concordat.** This is an agreement between <u>stakeholders</u> to improve the employment and support for researchers and researcher careers in higher education in the UK.

It sets out three clear <u>Principles</u> of environment and culture, employment, and professional and career development. The principles are underpinned by obligations for the four key stakeholder groups, funders, institutions, researchers and managers of researchers, to realise the aims of the Concordat.
