

Ceremony Arrangements Saturday 9 November 2019 at 11 am

On arrival

- 1 You will be able to enter the Main Building from **9 am**
- 2 Please register at the University's Registration Desk, which will be situated in the Foyer of Loke Yew Hall. You will be given a Graduate Ticket with your name, award and seat number printed on the reverse together with any purchased guest tickets.

- 5 Please be seated 30 minutes before the ceremony is due to commence. A section of Loke Yew Hall will be reserved for graduates only. You **must** have your Graduate Ticket with you during the Ceremony.
- 6 Your guests will be directed to the area reserved for guest seating in Loke Yew Hall. A programme will be provided as a souvenir of the occasion.

The ceremony

- 7 Each graduate seat is numbered and it is essential that you sit in the numbered seat that corresponds with the number on your graduate ticket. When you are directed to the stage to be presented **this ticket will be used to announce your name and the title of your award.**
- 8 Please follow the instructions given to you by stewards. Once you have shaken hands with the Provost and Deputy Vice-Chancellor and collected your commemorative certificate, you will be directed back to your original seat. Please remain in your seat until the end of the ceremony.
- 9 All graduates attending the ceremony will receive a commemorative certificate on the day.
- 10 The ceremony will end with the departure of the Academic Procession. Graduates and guests will follow on and process to the reception area where refreshments will be served. You will then have the opportunity to meet friends, family, colleagues and guests.
