## Section F: EXAMINATION AND ASSESSMENT

Regulation	Changes
F1.2.2	Addition of a new requirement for an external examiner to complete a
	satisfactory right to work check before examination arrangements can
	commence. The external examiner can only have the right to work check
	once they have been approved by the Faculty Research Degrees
	Committee.
F1.2.3	The approval date used to calculate the start of the 3-month period
	examination arrangements are valid for has been amended. The 3-month
	period now starts from the date the External Examiner(s) right to work check
	has been completed.
F1.2.5	The name of the FRDC has been included to provide clarity regarding the
	point from which the student and supervisors must ensure they do not have
	contact with the Examination Panel during the examination process.
F1.2.11	A new regulation that clarifies only one version of the thesis to be examined
	may be submitted prior to the oral examination. Students need to ensure
	the version of the draft thesis they are submitting for examination is the
	correct version. Once a draft thesis has been submitted and forwarded to
	the examiners, no changes can be made.
