How we can work together

Franchised Programmes:

This refers to existing (or sometimes, modified versions of existing) University of Greenwich programmes which have been approved for delivery on campus, and which may also be approved ('franchised') for delivery by an external partner.

Articulation Agreement:

These involve a formal link between UoG and an external partner, providing a guarantee that a cohort of students who achieve an agreed standard in a programme at the partner will be able to progress to a particular stage of an award-bearing programme in the UoG, provided there is a close curriculum 'fit' for articulation purposes.

Progression Agreement:

The University recognises progression from a programme a student has completed at a partner institution, either to the beginning or to a more advanced stage of an award-bearing programme in the UoG. Applications are received on an individual basis.

Joint award:

A programme developed jointly with at least one other institution, which may also have degree awarding powers, leading to a Greenwich award, or a degree awarded jointly by both institutions.

Dual Award:

A programme of study jointly delivered by a partner institution and the UoG leading to the granting of both a Greenwich award and that of the partner institution.



How to become a partner

After initial consideration by the relevant host Faculty and International Partnerships Office, the application process for prospective partners comprises two stages:

- approval of the partner
- approval of the programme.

Partnership model: Franchise

We celebrate a significant relationship with one of our most esteemed partners, FPT University in Vietnam. The partnership was established in 2009 and rapidly evolving into one of our most substantial collaborations.

Our educational programmes have seen remarkable growth, recently expanding from the First Year Experience to a comprehensive three-year franchise.

Spread across four vibrant campuses in Ho Chi Minh, Da Nang, Hanoi, and Can Tho, over 4,000 students are engaged in pursuing a Greenwich degree, witness to our expanding global footprint.

We offer a wide range of multidisciplinary programmes in Business, Computing, and Graphic and Digital Design, reflecting our dedication to academic diversity and adaptability.

Our partnership is multifaceted, encompassing franchised operations, summer schools, and laying the groundwork for potential future research collaborations. In a landmark event, several FPT students were welcomed to the Greenwich campus for our inaugural summer school in August 2023, underscoring our commitment to international educational exchange and growth.

Partnership model: Franchise and Validation

In 2006, a partnership was forged with New York College that has since flourished into our most significant European alliance. This collaboration boasts two campuses situated in the historic cities of Athens and Thessaloniki.
